Chamber of Commerce Launches in Doraville

Three women-owned, small business executives tout “A World of Business All in One Place” and form one of the first official organizations in the city’s 150-year history.

DORAVILLE, Georgia, September 14, 2021 - Big things are happening in Doraville, and three business owners are taking action. Tammie Bailey-Fults, CEO and President of the Doraville Chamber of Commerce, formed the non-governmental private entity along with Director of Legal Affairs, Danielle C. Brown Dowell, and Marketing & Communications Director, Michele Palmer, to support the business community as the city enters a new phase of dynamic development.

Doraville is an undiscovered gem in the Atlanta metro area that is quickly gaining attention, and for good reason. Located at the crossroads of Buford Highway and I-285, and given its easy access to I-85 and MARTA, the city is an ideal location for companies looking to form, relocate or expand. “We quickly realized, especially in this pandemic season, the importance of having a voice, vision and resources to support the economic development of businesses in and around Doraville,” Bailey-Fults said.

A city known for its eclectic cuisine, Doraville’s inclusive culture and diverse global origins are of utmost importance to the Chamber. “The board has every intent to preserve the foundational business community while we welcome other innovative and diverse companies to the area,” Palmer said. “That’s reflected in our logo and tagline, as well as our website, which is currently available in five languages.”

The Chamber, launching virtually this week, has plans to secure an office in early 2022 that will include meeting space, a boardroom, and workspaces that can be reserved by members. In the meantime, the Chamber will work to expand its virtual network with boots-on-the-ground efforts. The Board of Directors is seeking volunteers to fill positions for a bi/multi-lingual Membership Coordinator, Event Coordinator, Social Media Coordinator, and Business Community Champions. “Many of our established local businesses operate uniquely based on their culture. It is important for the Chamber to have liaisons in place to assist us in understanding and supporting the needs of our diverse membership – forging a network that connects us all,” Brown Dowell explained.

The official Covid-safe Launch Event is tonight from 6pm-8pm at N3Dos Restaurant & Lounge located at 5803 Buford Hwy NE. The Board of Directors invites local business owners and managers to learn more about the Chamber and network with other businesses.
